





### The Official FIFA World Cup 2022™ Emblem

The FIFA World Cup™ emblem incorporates the burgundy and white colours that are synonymous with Qatar's national flag. The emblem's design embodies the vision of an event that connects and engages the entire world, while also featuring striking elements of local and regional Arab culture, as well as references to the beautiful game.

The swooping curves of the emblem represent desert dunes, and the unbroken loop depicts both the number eight – representing the tournament's host stadiums – and the infinity symbol, reflecting the event's interconnected nature, which fuses tradition with modernity.

Prominent Qatari artist, Bouthayna Al Muftah, uses photography to tell the captivating story of the Host Country through a series of eight posters: one main poster and seven different variations - encapsulating both the cultural and emotional feelings of the nation.

The inspiration behind Bouthayna's creative expression is the concept of a collective memory, born through thousands of years of Qatari heritage - borrowing elements from folklore and the oral history of Qatar and readapting them to reflect her relationship with her land's past.

This is an artistic series that conveys the values and messages of the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ in a subtle, unique and relevant way in close connection with local culture and heritage.





The main poster focuses on the football itself, with the agal (a traditional headpiece worn in Qatar) providing the cultural reference. The associated typography is typical of Bouthayna's artistic aesthetic and expresses the voices of a cheering crowd.

Just like the beautiful game, the artist's approach is very raw and emotive, packed with palpable movement and energy.



After passing the Pedestrian Screening Area (PSA), fans will enter the Fan Experience Area where they can enjoy live streaming of matches at other stadiums, live on-stage performances and a host of interactive activities.

Food and beverage concessions will offer a variety of hot and cold food, as well as hot and cold beverages.

A great range of quality merchandise will be available for purchase in the Fan Experience Area and upon reaching the stadiums at FIFA World Cup™ Stores.

All food and beverage concessions and FIFA World Cup™ Stores accept Visa payment options and cash.

The Fan Experience Area will open from Gate Opening until one hour after the final whistle. The area will be closed during the match.

We encourage fans to arrive at the stadium early so they can enjoy everything the Fan Experience

### How to Pay with Visa at the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™

FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ proudly accepts only Visa payment products including credit, debit and mobile payments, along with cash, at all stadiums to pay for food, beverages and official licensed products. For the convenience of all fans arriving without a Visa product, the ability to purchase a Visa gift card will be made available at all official sites. At the FIFA Fan Festival™, only Visa payment products will be accepted to buy official licensed products at the Superstore and will be the preferred way to pay at all food and beverages locations.

For inquiries related to Visa products and services, please visit Visa gift card locations onsite at stadiums, the Visa website at www.visa.com, or contact Visa's Global Customer Services toll-free from Qatar at 0080 010 1134. For collect calls, please call +1-303-967-1090 (collect calls are placed using the local operator).

Visa cardholders are reminded to contact their issuing banks before leaving their home country for Qatar to alert them of their travel plans and purchases in another country. Cardholders should also ask about daily withdrawal limits, Qatar National Bank (QNB) ATM fees and other fees.

### Qatar National Bank (QNB) ATMs at the FIFA World Cup Oatar 2022™

There will be a minimum of one QNB ATM and a maximum of four QNB ATMs per stadium for the convenience of all fans.

### 2.2 Safety, Security & Prohibited Items

Our number one priority is the safety and security of all FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ patrons. Our staff are fully trained in all safety & security procedures – but it won't hurt if you're aware of them too!

In this section you'll find what to expect when you arrive at the stadiums, as well as the items you aren't allowed to bring in.

### **Entering the stadiums**

You need a valid ticket and your Hayya Card to enter the stadiums – make sure you keep these on your person at all times in case of inspection.

Your ticket will have information about what time the gates open. All ticketholders must pass through safety and security screening. We recommend that you arrive with enough time before the match to account for possible traffic and gueues.

Please follow the instructions of stadium personnel and FIFA's Stadium Code of Conduct, which details prohibited behaviours and items.

### Here are some tips to help you get through security faster:

- Check the prohibited items list before you come to the stadium. The full list is available in the Stadium Code of Conduct, which can be accessed through the QR code at the end of the page."
- ◆ Have your ticket and Hayya Card ready at the gate
- Be ready to take off your jacket or coat, scarf and other accessories
- Be prepared to empty your pockets try to avoid having loose change

Security personnel and event staff will be at every stadium to help make your FIFA World Cup™ experience safe and secure. If you have any safety concerns, please approach them and ask for assistance.

### **Restricted Items Storage**

Fans can store items that are not allowed in the stadium at Restricted Items Storage, which is located in close proximity to all the stadium entrances. The service is free of charge.



### **Examples of Prohibited items**

Flags, banners and posters larger than 2x1.5m.

Smaller or equal to the above size flags, banners and posters are allowed if they are made from a material categorised as low-fire hazard, are compliant with and not prohibited by the stadium code of conduct.

If you want to bring flags, banners or posters larger than 2x1.5m, please contact fan@2022.qa.





Any musical instruments (mechanical or manual) that do not fit easily within the window of the X-ray baggage scanner (being 60 cm x 40 cm) for security screening.

Individuals carrying permitted instruments shall be informed in case of any complaints from other spectators due to the usage of these items.



Spectators can only bring one package per type of medical drug or product, of up to seven different types, in any form (including aerosols, drops, syringes, asthma inhalers or any other asthma related products, etc.).



Backpacks/ rucksacks larger than 75cm³ (except sensory bags usedby people with sensory requirements).



Matches and lighters.



Mounts for photo or video equipment, including tripod and selfie sticks.



Spectators can only bring one power bank of any size or any other type of battery device.

Food and beverages or any liquids larger than 100ml.

### **Prohibited Actions**



Starting a fire or launching pyrotechnics at the tadium or an adjacent territory.



Distributing or consuming narcotic or psychotropic substances, or any potentially dangerous psychoactive substances or opiates.



Reselling match tickets and/or any documents entitling their holders to receive match tickets.



Gambling, betting



Actions that could cause crowding in a manner that creates the risk of a stampede or public disturbances, including occupying staircases and concourse areas during the match.



Unauthorised access of the stadium and restricted zones not specified on your



Holding any public actions not outlined in the guidelines of the Event or promoting any political, offensive and/ or discriminatory messages.



Smoking and vaping is only allowed if outdoor designated smoking areas have been made available, as per the FIFA Event Policu on Tobacco.



Selling goods or conducting any type of business on the territory of the stadium and/or an adjacent territory.



Broadcasting or recording for commercial gain.

### 2.3 Children at Stadiums

We welcome fans of all ages to our stadiums. Here is some helpful information for parents and guardians.

- All children, regardless of their age, must have a ticket and a Hayya Card to attend a match
- All children and adolescents under the age of 15 must always be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian on matchdays
- Parents with infants and pregnant women can enter the stadium through the priority lanes – please ask our volunteers to guide you
- Baby milk and sterilised water not exceeding
   1 litre per child are allowed in the stadiums

- Family rooms/ baby changing facilities are available in all stadiums
- Register your children at the stadium information points for ease of mind.
   Your child will be provided with a bracelet.
   Write their name and your mobile number on the bracelet to assist event staff in case your child gets lost during the match
- Contact the nearest steward or security guard at the stadium to report any concern related to the welfare of a child.

### 2.4 Lost & Found Claim Centre

Lost your phone, camera or your child's favourite teddy bear? Don't worry – there's a Lost & Found Service at the Information Points inside the security perimeter at all FIFA World Cup 2022™ venues.

All lost & found items will be safely stored at the Information Points, and our friendly volunteers will help reunite them with their rightful owners during operational hours.

Any items that are not retrieved by the end of matchday will be collected and taken to Qatar Post's General Post Office in central Doha awaiting your collection.

### 2.5 Accessibility at Stadiums

### Arriving by car

There are a limited number of accessible parking spaces located close to the stadiums, which are designated for disabled spectators, who have Wheelchair User, Easy Access Standard and Easy Access Amenity tickets.



These ticket holders must obtain a Vehicle Access Parking Pass (VAPP) per match to use the accessible parking spaces, which are available on a firstcome, first-served basis.

### Stadium entry and priority lanes

All security check areas have dedicated accessible priority lanes, level access and extra width passing space for wheelchair users and people with limited mobility.

### Audio-descriptive commentary

Audio-descriptive commentary services (ADC) are provided for partially sighted and blind fans, in English and Arabic, at all eight stadiums for all matches. ADC allows spectators to listen to trained commentators describing the game through the FIFA Interpreting App. Download it using QR Code below. To access ADC service, spectators are requested to use their personal mobile phone and headphones.



Spectators with assistance dogs are permitted in all areas of the stadium. Relieving areas and water bowls are not available.



Accessible services and facilities are vital to creating a wonderful matchday experience for all fans attending the tournament. Each stadium has accessible gates, seats and helpful features for patrons who have Accessibility Tickets for the match.

### Mobility assistance points

This service is provided at all eight stadiums to assist wheelchair users and disabled people and limited mobility from the security areas to their seats.

Mobility Assistance Volunteers and Staff can provide assistance and venuespecific accessibility information, such as locations of accessible toilets, accessible gates, other accessible facilities and the audio-descriptive commentary (ADC) service.

Wheelchairs and golf carts are available at all Mobility Assistance Points so disabled spectators can get to their seats. Mobility Assistance Volunteers can also assist disabled spectators to get to the exit gates after the final whistle.

### **Accessible toilets**

Wheelchair-accessible toilets and cubicles suitable for disabled spectators are located close to accessible seating areas and can be accessed directly from the concourse.



The space within the compartments allows wheelchair users and people with limited mobility to approach, transfer to and use sanitary facilities.

These are usually accessible unisex WC or enlarged cubicles in a separate-sex washroom.

### **Changing Places toilets**

These toilets are for use by disabled people who require the help of up to two assistants. At least one changing places toilet is provided in each stadium.

Changing places toilets are equipped with a hoist, basin, WC, adult-sized changing bench and a shower. Please request access from the Information Points located on the stadium's concourses.



### Accessible food & beverage concessions

Food and beverage concessions located close to accessible seating areas have a low-level counter and/ or a priority lane. Trained volunteers are available to help with access.

### Sensory rooms

Sensory viewing rooms are provided in the SkyBoxes of Education City, Al Bayt and Lusail Stadiums. They benefit spectators with sensory processing disabilities, mental health requirements or dementia.



### **Baby changing facility**

Baby changing facilities are provided on the concourses, each are equipped with a wall-hung changing bed and a wash basin.

### 2.6 Inclusivity

Everyone deserves a fair and inclusive tournament experience that is welcoming, safe and accessible, while respecting their rights.

Any form of discrimination is prohibited at all FIFA tournaments, as per Article 4 of the FIFA Statutes. If you experience or witness offensive or discriminatory behaviour during the FIFA World Cup 2022™. we encourage you to report the incident to tournament staff, safety security personnel and/or to the FIFA World Cup 2022™

For the delivery of the human rights volunteer project, FIFA has partnered with the Centre for Sport and Human Rights, a global organisation promoting human rights in sports.



### 3.1 Introduction to the Stadiums

Each venue has been developed in tribute to Qatar's rich traditions, heritage and location which intertwine beautifully with modern, state-of-the-art design features, offering a unique world of discovery, as well as the optimum fan experience for all stadium visitors.

Meeting Qatar's commitment to host a sustainable FIFA World Cup™, each of our venues have a focus on leaving a lasting legacy. From the methods and materials used in their construction, to their carefully considered post-tournament roles in Qatar and developing countries, the aim is that these stadiums inspire similar practices for future events across the region and around the world.

> Remember! Plan ahead and allow enough time for your journey. You may encounter areas of heavy traffic and queues at the security check points. The longest distance between stadiums is 75km (Al Baut Stadium to Al Janoub Stadium). The shortest distance is just 5km (Education Citu Stadium to Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium).





### 3.2 Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium

Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium sits proudly at the gateway to the desert. The stadium's design is inspired by aspects of the local culture and traditions. This can be seen in the intricate facade, which mirrors the sweeping undulations of the nearby sand dunes, while beautiful geometric patterns depict different characteristics of the country.

### How to get to **Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium**

Ahmad Bin Ali Stadium is located 20km west of central Doha and will host seven matches from the group stage to the round of 16.

# 3.9 Stadium 974

Located on the shores of the Gulf, across the water from Doha's dazzling West Bay skyline, Stadium 974 is the world's first fully demountable covered football stadium.

Inspired by Qatar's strong history in seafaring and trade, this stadium is constructed entirely from shipping containers and modular steel.

The deconstructed elements of the venue will continue to be utilised for years and even decades after this FIFA World Cup™.

40,000-capacity arena

Constructed from 974 shipping containers

The clever modular design means that fewer building materials were required than in traditional stadiums – keeping construction costs down, reducing waste and putting sustainabilitu at its core

Stadium 974 is located off the Ras Abu Abboud Expressway along the shore of the Persian Gulf, about 10km east of central Doha. It will host seven matches from the group stage to the round of 16.





# **Parking at Stadiums**

All eight World Cup™ stadiums offer parking areas for spectators. Stadium car parks will open 4 hours before the start of the match and conclude their operations 1.5 hours after the final whistle.

Parking is first come, first served. No booking facilities are available.

Depending on the stadium, you can either walk from the car park to the stadium gates or you will need to use the shuttle bus or tram service. Check out the journey planner in your Hayya to Qatar 2022 app before setting off.

# 5.1 Arrivals & Departures

Qatar has two airports that welcome football fans from around the world.

# **Hamad International Airport** Air-ticket code: DOH

- The main gateway to Qatar and home to the national carrier airline, Qatar Airways. Located 15 minutes from central Doha and within 30 minutes from most of the tournament stadiums
- A wide variety of transport options connect the airport to the city. Follow the signage in the terminal to reach the taxi pavilion, tournament buses, city buses or the metro station
- Hamad International Airport T1 Metro Station (Red Line) offers a fast and frequent service to and from the airport, connecting it with stadiums, the FIFA Fan Festival™ and other fan sites, and major cultural and tourist attractions in Doha

# **Doha International Airport** Air-ticket code: DIA

- ◆ This airport has two passenger terminals Arrival and Departure. Both terminals are located close to central Doha. The Arrivals terminal is 650m away from National Museum Metro Station (Gold Line) and the Departures terminal is 700m away from Al Matar Al Qadeem Metro Station (Red Line)
- ◆ Shuttle buses can take you from the arrivals terminal to Soug Wagif Bus Hub - South, where you can continue your journey by metro.

### Departure

Passenger Overflow Area (POA) in close proximity to both airports are available to departing passengers who report to airports more than four hours prior to their flight departure time.

### Land Border – Abu Samra

Abu Samra land border between Qatar and the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is located 90km from central Doha. Abu Samra welcomes guests arriving by vehicles.

During tournament time, fans travelling by road have three options to cross into Qatar:

- 1) Cross by bus
- 2) Park & Visit on Matchday
- 3) Cross with your own car\*

# 5.2 Moving around Doha

# **Travelling by Metro and Tram**

There are three metro lines and a tram network that connects fans to FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ venues, the FIFA Fan Festival™ and other key sites.

Both metro and tram operate from 6 AM to 3 AM Saturday to Thursday, and 9 AM to 3 AM on Fridays. Hayya Card holders will have complimentary access throughout the tournament to Standard Class or Family Class (if criteria is met).

The transfer station for Red/ Green interchange is Al Bidda station, which is close to the FIFA Fan Festival™. The Msheireb Metro Station connects all three metro lines (Red, Green and Gold).





Did you know the Doha Metro has no drivers?! But that doesn't slow these trains down. The average journey between Metro Stations is a speedu 2 minutes – almost as fast as I can flu there!

### **Gold Club Class**

In addition to the Standard and Family Class carriages, the metro also offers a Gold Club Class carriage, which can only be accessed by Gold Club card holders. Even if you are a Hayya Card holder, you will still need to buy the Gold Club card to access the Gold Club Class carriage.

### **Getting to the Metro**

Choosing the metro to travel? You have access to the free metrolink bus service to help you get within 2-5km of metro stations and useful locations.


# **Travelling by Bus**

The public buses - known as Karwa buses - operate an extensive network across the central and greater Doha area. Keep track of timetables and routes on the Karwa Bus app (iOS and Android) or the Mowasalat website.

If you are travelling to a match, please be aware that Karwa public buses do not provide direct services to/ from stadiums. For matchday transport, please refer to information in Chapter 4.

# Luggage on Public Transport

Passengers are encouraged to travel as light as possible. If you are transporting large amounts of luggage, you should consider using a taxi or on-demand service as you may risk being turned away from using public buses or the metro during busy times.



# **Travelling by Taxi**

Karwa is the official taxi service company in Qatar. You can easily spot them by their turquoise-coloured vehicles or logo.

You can book in advance for these services through the Karwa Taxi app (also accessible through the Hayya to Qatar 2022 app) or by calling +974 800 8294 (toll free). Or, hail a taxi from the roadside or pavement.

Most offer credit or debit card payment facilities.

Karwa has vehicles that serve passengers with disabilities and can offer car seats for babies and small children.



# **Arabic phrases**

Almost everyone in Qatar speaks English, but why not make use of these Arabic phrases to show off to your friends and impress the locals.

### Did uou know?

- ◆ The Qatari Riyal (QAR) is the only currency used in the country. You can withdraw cash at ATMs, which are widely available in malls, hotels and banks around the country
- ◆ You drive on the right hand side of the road in Qatar
- ♦ In winter, temperatures range from 17-24C. You can expect it to be sunny and sometimes breezy. It might rain or storm occasionally
- ◆ The first day of the week is Sunday and the weekend is Friday and Saturday

- ◆ The time zone is GMT +3
- Qatar is a Muslim country and the Islamic faith plays an integral role in daily life
- Prayers take place five times per day: at dawn (Fajr), around midday (Duhr), in mid-afternoon (A'asr), at sunset (Maghrib) and about two hours after sunset ('Esha). The exact timing varies each day according to the sun's position
- The holy day is Friday so banks and other services will be closed. Some shops also close a couple of hours before midday prayers and reopen afterwards, so check opening hours before you head out

# **Inclusive communication**

The FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ will bring people together from all corners of the globe. This is a unique opportunity for connection and dialogue that we hope you will embrace. Here are some tips to help create a welcoming atmosphere.

- ◆ Be open, approachable and polite
- Be patient and understanding, as the person you are talking to may not be speaking in their native language
- Listen actively. Let your body language and facial expressions show you are listening
- Be aware that hand gestures can differ significantly from country to country.
- ◆ Respect personal space and remain cautious when using body language and non-verbal communication to underline what you are saying
- Be flexible and open to different perspectives and point of views, even if they are different to your own
- ◆ Ask questions and make sure you understand a situation fully rather than jumping to conclusions
- ◆ Treat everyone with respect and kindness
- ◆ For specific cultural guidance, please reach out to your respective diplomatic representation or embassy

Get your adrenaline pumping as you round the bends at the Losail Circuit Sports Club. With two great tracks for speedy karting action, it's fun for all ages.




Did uou know that there are no mountains in Oatar?

The home to Qatar's marketplace for over a century, Soug Wagif remains true to its roots. If you want to experience traditional culture. sample incredible local and international dishes, explore a labyrinth of cardamomscented paths and tunnels and shop until you drop - look no further. This is a corner of Qatar not to be missed.





### The Museum of Islamic Art

MIA is not just one of Qatar's most famous museums but also an iconic landmark, offering memorable exhibitions and incredible views. Discover the richness of Islamic art and its influence around the world.



### Katara Cultural Village

Katara Cultural Village is named after the very first reference to Qatar on ancient maps (first spelled as Catara in 150 AD), and in true Qatari style blends a mix of tradition and modernism. Cleary seen in its design and function - a hub for theatre, dance, music, visual arts, literature and poetry, as well as conventions and exhibitions at the beautiful amphitheatre.

### Imam Muhammad ibn Abd al-Wahhab Mosaue

Qatar's largest mosque, also known as the Grand Mosque is built on the original site of the mosque of Qatar's founder Sheikh Jassim bin Mohammed Al Thani. After dark, its striking and enormous fort-like appearance is illuminated by strategically placed lighting.



### **Doha Film Institute**


Located within Katara Cultural Village is the Doha Film Institute, a national organisation dedicated to building film culture in Qatar. The institute champions emerging local talent and individuals from around the world, providing financial support and hands-on creative assistance.

### History

### Al Zubarah Fort

The focal point of the Al Zubarah Archaeological Site, a UNESCO World Heritage site, the Al Zubarah Fort is a pristine example of a typical Arab fort from the 18th century. Visitors can see the original residential palaces, mosques, courtvard houses, fishermen huts, streets. double defensive walls, a harbour, a canal and cemeteries.





This is the best place to see working dhow boats up close in Qatar, where hundreds of dhows in traditional designs are unloaded of their catch of the day by local fishermen.

### Soug Al Wakrah

Explore the traditional architecture and aged clay structures at tranquil Soug Al Wakrah and you'll discover so much more. There's a small mosque, stables and shops selling honey, spices, perfumes and souvenirs. Round off your visit with a camel ride or enjoy dinner at one of the very reasonably priced beachfront restaurants. It's a gem of a trip you'll treasure forever.



### **Forts**

Built to protect the surrounding area from invaders and to keep the region safe, Qatar has a number of forts dating back to the 19th and 20th century, providing an insight to life here 200-300 years ago.

### **Zekreet Stone Formations**

Explore Ras Abroug and you'll feel like you've iust landed on the moon.

Mushroom-shaped limestone rock formations sculpted by nature dominate the entire area.

### Art

### **Fire Station Gallery**

For 30 years this location served as the home for the region's firefighters. Now, this building houses a contemporary art gallery as well as multiple studios to support a new wave of artists. Go check out the cool graffiti and enjoy a coffee.

### **Gallery Al Riwag**

For the very best works of international, regional and local artists head to Al Riwag Gallery. The exhibits change frequently, are always well-curated and never fail to surprise and inspire.



### **ledariart Street Art**

If you're an art lover, you're in the right place. Marvel at the mesmerising and thought provoking artworks in our galleries, and keep your eyes peeled for the incredible street art placed in strategic locations around the city. like bridges, underpasses and buildings each telling its own unique story.

### Al Jassasiya Rock Carvings

Located in the northeast of Qatar, Al Jassasiya is the most impressive of Qatar's historic rock-carving - or petroglyph - sites. Once a well-kept secret, you can now discover over 900 carvings of fish, feet, rosettes, ships and rows of cups representing aspects of the lives of the people who once lived here.

### Mathaf: Arab Museum of Modern Art

Showcasing art created in Qatar and across the Middle East, Mathaf brings people together to learn, share ideas and enter into debate. From public talks by artists to weekly art lessons, Mathaf works tirelessly to support the growth of modern Arab art.



### **Richard Serra Sculptures**

East-West/ West-East is a permanent art installation by sculptor Richard Serra in Broug Nature Reserve, Zekreet, Four towering steel sculptures, each over 14m tall, rise from the sand covering a full kilometre of desert.

# **7.1 Medical Services**

Qatar's healthcare sector has undergone an enormous journey of transformation in recent years and operates a modern, advanced system delivering a comprehensive range of medical services at the highest international standards.



Visitors coming to Qatar for the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ can access medical care at any of the country's private or public hospitals, medical centres, clinics and pharmacies.



For both urgent and non-urgent cases, all visiting fans can access medical treatment at one of the many high-quality public and private hospitals or medical clinics in Qatar.

A comprehensive list of private medical facilities can be found on the Ministry of Public Health website at <a href="https://www.moph.gov.qa">www.moph.gov.qa</a>

Visiting fans who have private travel insurance with healthcare coverage should check with the private healthcare sector medical facilities for payment terms and conditions as per the insurance policy.

For non-life-threatening, urgent medical conditions, visit an urgent care unit at one of the following Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC) hospitals:

- 1. Sheikha Aisha bint Hamad Al Attiyah Hospital
- 2. Al Wakra Hospital
- 3. Hamad General Hospital

These urgent care units provide 24-hour walk-in care for patients with non-threatening medical needs, such as minor burns, sprains, severe headache or earache, high fever, dehydration and dizziness.

Fans can access emergency and urgent medical services at HMC facilities free of charge throughout the tournament. To receive these services free of charge, fans must present their Hayya Card to the healthcare facility.

These are open 7 days a week, from 7 AM-11 PM, for your general medical needs.

For both urgent and non-urgent cases, you can also visit a private hospital or medical clinic

# Children (under 14s)

The majority of public and private healthcare centres can provide medical care to children. However, for specialised emergency and urgent medical services, we recommend Hamad Medical Corporation's Pediatric Emergency Centres (PECs) or Sidra Medicine. These provide high-quality, safe and compassionate clinical care to children. The main PEC is located in Al Sadd and serves as a hub for other PECs across Qatar.

### **Pharmacies**

Qatar has hundreds of local pharmacies providing over-the-counter medication and basic healthcare advice for minor conditions, including colds, allergies, rashes and mild pains.


